


MARCH MADNESS AND PROBLEM GAMBLING


There's a reason why March is National Problem Gambling Awareness Month — it's because of the "Madness" that ensues during the annual NCAA basketball tournament.



From high-stakes bracket pools to non-stop betting lines on sportsbooks, gambling is very tempting in March, even for those who rarely gamble or watch sports.




The legal age to participate in sports betting in CT is 21.
